



HMLA-167 Substance Abuse Policy

Alcohol and substance abuse undercut our core values, degrade unit readiness, and put Marines, their families, and those we defend at risk. Alcohol and substance abuse are unacceptable and Marines of all ranks have a responsibility to curtail it whenever and wherever it may occur.

HMLA-167 will engage in an aggressive campaign to prevent and eliminate alcohol and substance abuse. The focus of effort will be on education, prevention, detection, and appropriate discipline for offenders.

This multi-method effort will arm our Marines, Sailors, and their families with the knowledge and leadership skills necessary to prevent substance abuse issues before they develop into serious problems.

We will take care of our fellow Marines through intervention and timely identification. Leaders will refer anyone deemed to have experienced a detrimental drug or alcohol incident to the Substance Abuse Control Officer. The command will afford the Marine or Sailor the appropriate treatment if diagnosed as drug or alcohol dependent.

We must ensure that every member of the Warriors is committed to preventing substance abuse. The abuse of these substances destroys the health of our Marines and Sailors, their families, and careers. Leaders at all levels shall use all available resources to eliminate substance abuse.
