Duties of a Family Readiness Officer (*Include but are not limited to...*)

- ➤ Official communication and family outreach
- ➤ Ensure command policy regarding information flow to families of single and married Marines.
- ➤ Manage, coordinate, and promote all matters pertaining to Family Readiness and serve as the point of contact for family readiness issues.
- ➤ Subject matter expert on base, local, national, and web-based resources that are available.
- ➤ Provide education and ongoing communication during a deployment cycle, including pre-deployment and return and reunion briefs.
- Volunteer management and support (i.e. graduation ceremonies, volunteer appreciation, and FR meetings)
- ➤ Implementation and management of the unit eMarine website.


The Squadrons listed in this brochure are currently specific to MAG-29 and located at MCAS New River or MCAS Cherry Point, both in North Carolina.
